

Precinct Chairperson

Purpose: The position of Precinct Chairperson actively supports the goals, policies, direction, and activities of the Republican Party and the Republican way of life. Through active involvement and commitment, the Precinct Chairperson becomes the critical backbone of the Republican Party providing key support to Republican candidates and elected officials while helping to meet Party requirements at all levels.

Duties and Responsibilities: The precinct Chair should have a basic understanding of our government, how it works, and the political parties that participate in this government. The following duties and responsibilities provide the foundational basis for the Precinct Chairperson position:

Understand the Election Process: One should have an understanding of the election process from a local, county, state, and national level. Precinct Chairs should be comfortable enough to be able to answer questions a constituent may have while promoting voter registration, an involvement in the election process.

Understand the Republican Party: Every Precinct Chair must understand the organization and function of the Republican Party from the county, district, state, and national level.

Promoting the Republican Way of Life: As a representative of the Republican Party, one must espouse and promote its way of life while potentially helping others to understand this concept.

Assist Republican Candidates: Republican candidates, at all levels, are competitively seeking public office to help our community, state, and nation while perpetuating our way of life. As Precinct Chair, one of the primary duties is to actively support all Republican candidates seeking public office.

Actively Support Elected Republican Officials: Elected Republican officials, at all levels, support the Republican way of life while protecting and guiding our communities, state, and nation. It is the Precinct Chair's responsibility to actively support, and if necessary, assist each elected official.

Actively Support Republican Activities: Activities such as party meetings and fundraisers as well as election activities and candidate support require consistent dedication from those who serve as Precinct Chairs. Active attendance at party meetings and volunteer work for campaign drives exemplify this level of dedication.

Actively Recruit Qualified Republicans for Office: Qualified candidates and volunteers are constantly needed to fill political office and Republican Party vacancies. Each Precinct Chair should actively look for and promote potential candidates and volunteers for these positions.
